



# INTERNATIONAL WARRANTY

## FOR INDUSTRIAL GENERATING SET ENGINES

### GENERAL

GUANGXI YUCHAI POWER Co. Ltd, Yulin City, China (further YUCHAI) guarantees the Product is free from defects in material and workmanship for the Limited Warranty Period under the conditions and with the limitations specified in this Warranty Statement. Any parts used for repair or replacement during the Warranty Period will benefit from the same warranty assurances as set out above for the remaining time of the Warranty Period.

### WARRANTY PERIODS

The limited warranty's validity begins at the time the engine was delivered to the first dealer or user and will continue for the period listed under the heading WARRANTY PERIODS.

The Warranty Coverage commences on the date of the invoice and continues for the duration stated below, limited by the Rating Definition.

- Industrial diesel engines for Genset applications, GE prime, PRP rating definition: 24 (twenty four) months without limitation of working hours
- Industrial diesel engines for Genset applications stand-by, ESP rating definition: 48 (forty eight) months or a one thousand (1000) hours, what occurs first.

This Warranty is applicable to all Owners in the sales channel, and the Coverage continues to all subsequent Owners until the duration of the Coverage expires.

### POWER DEFINITIONS

#### PRP = Prime Power

It corresponds to the prime rated power (PRP) of GB/T 2820 and ISO 8528, and refers to the maximum power accessible at the variable load for an unlimited running hours per year, with the maintenance intervals and procedures being carried out as prescribed by YUCHAI, the allowed average output power within 24 h shall not be higher than 70% of the prime power. There is allowed 10% overload per 1 hour within 12 hours operation.

#### ESP = Standby Power

It corresponds to the emergency standby power (ESP) of GB/T 2820 and ISO 8528, and refers to the maximum power accessible at a certain variable load series in the

event of a utility power outage or under test conditions for an limited running hours up to 300 h per year, with the maintenance intervals and procedures being carried out as prescribed by YUCHAI. The allowed average output power within 24 h shall not be higher than 70% of the standby power. There is no overload allowed.

### THE WARRANTY COVERS

YUCHAI will either repair or replace defective Products or parts, whichever is decided by YUCHAI. A defective Product which is covered by this International Limited Warranty is a Product that is found to have an inherent defect which existed in it at the time of shipment from the relevant YUCHAI facility.

### THE WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER

This Warranty does not apply to any non-YUCHAI branded products, if any name plate or label has been removed from the YUCHAI product or its components. This warranty does not apply to defects caused by transportation, installation or repairs.

#### **This warranty does not apply to defects caused as a result of any of the following:**

- abnormal use
- carelessness, misuse
- competition use or preparation for competition use
- over or under loading
- insufficient lubrication
- normal wear and tear
- use of non-genuine YUCHAI spare parts
- incorrect installation or parameter setting
- inappropriate use of the product relative to the Rating Definitions
- inadequate maintenance not in accordance with the Operation/Maintenance Manual
- improper fuel, lube oil or coolant and/or contaminants in fuel, lube oil or coolant
- accidents
- natural phenomenon such as lighting, thunderbolts, flooding
- war, uprisings, acts of terror or other force majeure events
- improper storage
- corrosion
- failure to comply with Operator's Manuals,

- maintenance instructions, installation instructions or any other applicable YUCHAI instructions
- alterations or modifications of the Product, including alterations or modifications of software or electronic devices
- breaking of seals
- usage in violation of law or for unintended purposes
- service/maintenance performed by unauthorized YUCHAI personnel

#### **CLAIMING UNDER THE INTERNATIONAL WARRANTY**

It is the responsibility of the owner of an engine to report any defect in the indicated product to authorized YUCHAI service partner (see [www.yuchaimotor.com](http://www.yuchaimotor.com)) Such a report must be made as soon as possible and no later than fourteen (14) days from the date when the user first observed the defect or ought to have observed it and consequently in no case later than Warranty Period has expired. The owner is recommended to secure evidence of the date when the report was made.

#### **LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY**

The repair and replacement remedies described above are the sole and exclusive remedies available in respect of this International Warranty. YUCHAI is not liable to: breach of statutory duty, or otherwise, for any indirect, incidental or consequential loss (including, without limitation): loss of use, loss of income, loss or disturbance of production, loss of profits, loss of time, loss of property, cost of travelling, cost of transport, extra costs incurred to make the engine accessible, cost of docking and cranes, arising under or in connection with this International Limited Warranty. All warranty repairs must be carried out by an Authorized YUCHAI service partner during normal working hours. YUCHAI does not authorize anyone to assume any other liability on its behalf in connection with the sales of Products than described in this Warranty Statement. YUCHAI reserves the right to make any changes to products manufactured and/or sold at any time without prior notice and without incurring any liability or obligation to make the same or similar changes to products previously manufactured and/or sold.

#### **OWNER'S OBLIGATIONS**

As YUCHAI does not have any control over the installation of its Product(s) we recommend the owner to ensure that the YUCHAI Service Partner checks and ensures that the engine(s) is (are) installed correctly. A correct installation is an absolute condition for the validity of the YUCHAI International Warranty. It is the owner's obligation for the operation, maintenance and care of YUCHAI engine in accordance with the instructions and requirements stated in the Operator's Manual during and after the Warranty Period. Operation should be in accordance with the engine application definition. All services relating to the engines have to be performed by an authorized YUCHAI Service Partner.

1. The installation of the engine in the final product must be completed in accordance with YUCHAI published guidelines.
2. Engines must be stored in accordance with YUCHAI published guidelines.
3. Costs associated with labor overtime and premium shipping requested by the Partner/Owner/User.
4. All downtime expenses, fines, taxes, and other losses resulting from a Warrantable Failure.
5. Costs associated with the removal, and installation of engine in case of replacement under Warranty.
6. The cost of normal maintenance and depreciation.
7. Consequences of negligence, misuse, or accident involving the engine.
8. Consequences of any modification or alteration of the engine.
9. Costs of replacement/renting of equipment and property.
10. Costs of transporting the engine or the equipment in which it is installed to and from the location at which the warranty service is performed.
11. Costs incurred in gaining access to the engine, i.e., overcoming physical barriers such as walls, fences, floors, decks, rental of cranes or similar lifting equipment or building structures or lifts for removal and reinstallation.
12. Labor cost incurred during work performed out of the normal business days and hours.
13. Cost of lubricating oil, antifreeze, filter elements and other maintenance items replaced during the Warranty Repairs unless such items are not reusable due to the warranty Failure.
